1a(i)

The writer identifies the similarities of the boys and girls appearance as both being in their best party clothes and their tidiness and neatness. However, the big difference was that the boys became silly as time went on, whereas the girls remained smart.

1b(i)

The school song was sung in two languages, English and Setswana.

1c(i)(i)

When the children sing the national anthem, the writer states that they standing in attention and their hands were over their hearts. They sang the anthem with patriotic pride and in a solemn manner.

1c(i)(ii)

One of the effects of the national anthem on the writer, was that it involved him in the experience more. Secondly, he found himself standing in attention like the children who were singing.
