- **The company has also worked in partnership with European institutions, public agencies and other NGOs through public contracts like Earth Trust and 10 10.**
- **The company provides Social Welfare Fund in Ireland for 1000 people and has become the lead NGO for bringing 10 10 concepts into Ireland.**

Inclusion, Equality & Empowerment

- **Engaging citizens in environmental and public participation, as well as a number of private quality and environmental management groups and the wider public.**
- **Ensure public participation is made to be meaningful by having the public in understanding better environmental issues, particularly in relation to EU water.**
